




CERTIFICATE OF APPROVAL

This is to certify that **Australian Hunting Net Incorporated (Tasmanian branch)**, which conducts its activities on land for which the club has prior written permission for its members to shoot ('the properties'), is an approved club in accordance with the provisions of section 151 of the *Firearms Act 1996* ('the Act'). This approval is granted to **Robert William Cairns** ('the holder'), on behalf of the club.

Conditions of Approval

1. This authority relates to the possession and use of only Category A and B firearms by members of the club who participate in the club's shooting activities.
2. The holder will, on an annual basis, provide the Commissioner of Police with:
 - (a) a list of the name, address and firearms licence number of all club members who participate in the activities of the club; and
 - (b) proof of written permission for its members to shoot on the properties on which the club conducts its activities.
3. The club must ensure that only holders of an active firearms licence of a category for which the club is approved or a current (16-18 year old) Minor's Permit are permitted to possess and/or use a firearm and/or ammunition whilst participating in club activities.
4. **The club must sight an active firearms licence card or a current (16-18 year old) Minor's Permit prior to allowing the possession and/or use of a firearm and/or ammunition.** This condition extends to any visitor to the club who may be the holder of a corresponding firearms licence or junior permit/licence granted to them in another Australian jurisdiction.
5. The club must ensure that the holder of a current (16-18 year old) Minor's Permit is under the **immediate supervision** of the holder of a firearms licence at all times when in possession of a firearm and when using a firearm.
6. The holder is responsible for ensuring that all members of the club and visitors are aware of the provisions of Section 120 of the Act regarding restrictions relating to alcohol and drugs.
7. The club will notify the Commissioner of any change in their Office Bearers within fourteen (14) days of the change.
8. The club will, upon written request, supply the Commissioner with any documents relating to club rules, constitution, or other matters which are reasonably necessary for or incidental to the exercise of the Commissioner's powers under the Act.
9. The club must have a minimum of ten (10) current financial members at any time in order to be regarded by the Commissioner as an active club and in order to maintain this approval.
10. This approval may be cancelled in accordance with the provisions of Section 154 of the Act by notice in writing served upon the holder.
